

Don't Bet On It!

With March Madness just days away, remember that NCAA regulations prohibit student-athletes from wagering on any collegiate sport or its professional athletics equivalent.

This Means You CAN'T...

- Make any sort of wager on college or professional sports in which you put something at risk (like an entry fee) for an opportunity to win something in return. Examples include:
 - Fantasy Leagues;
 - March Madness Brackets;
 - Online wagering;
 - Auctions in which bids are placed on teams, individuals, or contests;
 - Sports Pools;
 - Online Sports Bets;
 - Sports Parlay Cards; or
 - Any other gambling method employed by organized gambling.
- Accept a bet or bribe or agree to throw, fix, or illegally influence the outcome of any intercollegiate contest.
- Provide information about student-athletes or teams to individuals involved in any gambling activities.

The penalty for gambling is the loss of eligibility – at least one year, maybe more.
